Shingle Warranties

Standard Manufacturers Warranty

- Covers manufacturers defects for X number of years
- Typically only cover the cost of defective materials and not labor to remove and dispose of these materials
- Most warranties are prorated so you will have to pay a portion of the cost of shingles after X years
- Mostly only cover manufacturing defects, not mistakes made during installation.



Shingle Warranties

Contractors Workmanship Warranties

- Length of warranty will vary depending on contractor
- Cover the cost of materials and labor for time period due to faulty installation
- May also cover any interior damage due to faulty workmanship
- Typically do not cover
 - a. Storm, high wind, and impact damage
 - b. Water damage due to ice dams
 - c. Damages if the roof was altered after installation
 - d. Harm caused by foot traffic
 - e. Leaks triggered by falling limbs or wind-blown debris



Shingle Warranties


Extended Manufacturer's Warranties

- Must be installed by authorized contractors
- Typically require all approved products to be used such as ice/water barriers, underlayment, hip and ridge cap shingles, soffit and ridge vents, starter shingles

Do's and Dont's

DO'S

- Have your roof professionally inspected at least every 5 years.
- Make sure you have adequate attic ventilation.
- Keep debris off your roof. Clean gutters 2-3 times per year.
- Have the black algae or moss cleaned off your roof.
- Trim overhanging tree limbs.
- Get multiple quotes for roof replacements.
- Have each roofer give details (type of shingles, number of squares, starter shingles, ventilation, ice/water barriers, etc.).
- Compare workmanship warranties.



Do's and Dont's


DONT'S

- Try to climb on your roof if not experienced particularly if pitch is steep.
- Allow a roofer to overlay shingles on top of existing shingles.
- Go with the cheapest roofing quote without comparing all factors.
- Buy a house and let the seller put a new roof on it without you approving the contractor.
- Allow anyone on your roof with a pressure washer unless experienced.
- Let cousin Eddy try to fix leaks by putting tar all over the roof.


